### REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PROJECT AND RESIDENT ENGINEERING SERVICES

Notice is hereby given that the Burlington County Bridge Commission ("Commission") is requesting the submission of proposals ("Proposal") from consulting engineering firms ("Engineer") for professional project and resident engineering services.

Interested Engineers may obtain the Request for Proposals ("RFP") for these services by going to the Commission web site at [www.bcbridges.org](http://www.bcbridges.org).

This RFP is being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.

Nothing herein is intended to exclude any responsible Engineer or in any way restrain or restrict competition. All responsible Engineers are encouraged to submit Proposals.

All Engineers will be required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c. 127 (N.J.A.C. 17:27) Affirmative Action, P.L. 1977, c. 33 (N.J.A.C. 52:25-24.2) Statement of Ownership, and P.L. 2004, c. 57 and P.L. 2009, c.315 as amended (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44) New Jersey Business Registration.

Proposals must be received by the receptionist during regular Commission business hours no later than Tuesday, October 17, 2017 at 11:00 AM, prevailing time ("Submission Deadline"), addressed to the Burlington County Bridge Commission, 1300 Route 73 North, PO Box 6, Palmyra, NJ 08065-1090, ATTN: Purchasing. All Proposals must be enclosed in sealed envelopes and should bear the name and address of the Engineer and "Request for Proposals for Project & Resident Engineering Services" on the outside, including on the outside of any delivery service envelope. Regular Commission business hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM subject to Commission Holidays.

Facsimile Proposals shall not be accepted. Late Proposals will not be accepted and will be returned unopened to the Engineer. The Commission reserves the right to reject any and all Proposals, to waive any requirement of the RFP, to modify or amend (with the consent of the Engineer) the Proposal, and to effect any agreement deemed to be in the best interest of the Commission. All Proposals become the sole property of the Commission.

The preparation of the Proposal shall be at the expense of the Engineer. The Commission will not reimburse any Engineer for any costs associated with the preparation or submittal of any Proposal. It is the responsibility of the Engineer to fully examine the RFP and to respond accordingly.
