REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR TRAFFIC ENGINEERING SERVICES

The Burlington County Bridge Commission (“Commission”) is seeking proposals for traffic engineering services related to the study of traffic economics and toll revenue projection for the Tacony-Palmyra and Burlington-Bristol Bridges located in Burlington County, New Jersey. The purpose of this updated study is to:

- A. Review historical traffic patterns for a set period including E-ZPass penetration rates;
- B. Project traffic and revenue associated with the current toll schedule and various new pricing scenarios provided to the selected firm (“Firm”) by the Commission; and
- C. Provide an updated report that will ultimately be incorporated into an official statement for a revenue bond offering planned to permanently finance the Commission’s outstanding \$49,525,000 Bridge System Subordinated Revenue Notes, Series 2016 which were issued to fund the Commission’s 5 Year Capital Program.

Interested Firms may obtain the Request for Proposals (“RFP”) for these services by going to the Commission web site at www.bcbridges.org. It is the responsibility of prospective respondent’s to check the Commission’s website for any addenda issued prior to the proposal opening. Failure to do so can result in the rejection of your submission. This RFP is being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.

Nothing herein is intended to exclude any responsible Firm or in any way restrain or restrict competition. All responsible Firms are encouraged to submit Proposals.

All Firms will be required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c. 127 (N.J.A.C. 17:27) Affirmative Action, P.L. 1977, c. 33 (N.J.A.C. 52:25-24.2) Statement of Ownership, and P.L. 2004, c. 57 and P.L. 2009, c.315 as amended (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44) New Jersey Business Registration.

Proposals must be received by the receptionist during regular Commission business hours no later than Wednesday, July 19, 2017 at 9:00 AM, prevailing time, addressed to the Burlington County Bridge Commission, 1300 Route 73 North, PO Box 6, Palmyra, NJ 08065-1090, ATTN: Purchasing Agent. All Proposals must be enclosed in sealed envelopes and must bear the name and address of the Firm submitting and “Request for Proposals for Traffic Engineering Services” on the outside, including on the outside of any delivery service envelope. Regular Commission business hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM subject to Commission Holidays.

Facsimile and late proposals will not be accepted. Late proposals will be returned unopened to the Firm. The Commission reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to waive any requirement of the RFP, to modify or amend (with the consent of the Firm) the proposal, and to effect any agreement deemed to be in the best interest of the Commission. All proposals become the sole property of the Commission.

The preparation of the proposal shall be at the expense of the Firm. The Commission will not reimburse any Firm for any costs associated with the preparation or submittal of any proposal. It is the responsibility of the Firm to fully examine the RFP and to respond accordingly.
